Device Collection Update

Chromebook Collection/Audits:

- Elementary: All K-5 Chromebooks and hot spots will be collected from in-person and virtual students during the week of June 14th. Hot spots will be returned to the IT Department and Chromebooks will be stored at each building.
- Secondary: Rising 7 11th grade students will have the option to keep their Chromebooks over the summer. All Chromebooks will be audited, and a device agreement form will be sent home to parents/guardians. Students wanting to keep the Chromebooks over the summer must have had a successful audit and returned a signed device agreement form. Hot spots will also be collected during the week of June 14th.

Virtual Instruction for the 2021-2022 School Year

Virtual Instruction

- Students approved for virtual instruction will be enrolled in Virtual Virginia by July 15, 2021.
- Virtual Virginia is a four-day instructional program that is 100% synchronous.

Virtual Instruction Approval Process

- Each school has formed an approval committee.
- Approvals are based on medical requests, previous academic success, performance on SOLs, and attendance.
- Approval/denial letters will be mailed to parents beginning in June and before June 30^{th.}
- Approval letters will be accompanied by a virtual instruction agreement and a Virtual Virginia resource guide.
- Deadline for Virtual Virginia enrollment is July 15, 2021



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
